



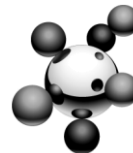
ANNOUNCEMENT OF SUCCESSFUL APPLICATIONS FOR THE DST-NRF-SASOL INZALO MASTERS AND DOCTORAL SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2016

The National Research Foundation (NRF) and the Department of Science and Technology (DST) in partnership with the Sasol Inzalo Foundation are pleased to announce the provisional awards for the DST-NRF-Sasol Inzalo Scholarship for Masters and Doctoral Studies in 2016. The list of successful applications, to date, for Masters and Doctoral scholarships are listed in Table 1 and Table 2 respectively.

The NRF regrets that it is still in the process of consolidating the review recommendations of all applications and apologises for the delay in announcing the outcome of the outstanding applications. A further announcement will be made in January 2016 with additional scholarship awards for 2016.

- If your name does not appear in either of the two tables, it means that the outcome of your application is pending and you will be informed of the outcome of your application in January 2016.
- The NRF will forward award letters to successful candidates in January 2016.



- Feedback to unsuccessful candidates will only be provided between January and March in 2016 due to processing of funding outcomes for various funding instruments.
- Once you have received the Conditions of grant (CoG), please read through the written agreement carefully before accepting the award.
- All signed and completed documentation must be forwarded to the NRF *via* your university postgraduate funding office, research office or financial aid office.
- Funds will only be released once the completed documentation has been received by the NRF.
- Awards not taken up by 31 July 2016, will be automatically cancelled, unless otherwise approved by the NRF.
- The Sasol Inzalo foundation will communicate with all successful applicants through your university postgraduate funding office, research office or financial aid office, in relation to the Sasol Inzalo foundation contribution towards your scholarship.

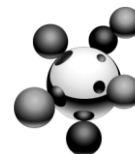
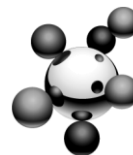

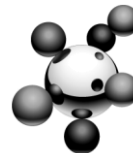
