- Should you not meet the relevant requirements, the NRF reserves the right not to award the scholarship.
- Funds will only be released once the completed documentation has been received by the NRF.

- Provisional awards that are not taken up by end of April 2023, will be automatically cancelled, unless otherwise approved by the NRF.
- If your name does not appear in the link provided, you have not been awarded a scholarship for 2023.
- Feedback to unsuccessful candidates will be provided in April 2023.
- The NRF provides feedback to unsuccessful candidates *via* the NRF Connect against your application.

**The NRF reserves the right to withdraw and cancel the scholarship should the applicant fail to meet all necessary conditions and/or requirements as stated in the NRF Postgraduate Scholarships Call for 2023, the Framework document and the Conditions of Grant.**
