



ANNOUNCEMENT OF SUCCESSFUL APPLICATIONS FOR THE NRF-DAAD MASTERS AND DOCTORAL SCHOLARSHIPS FOR FUNDING IN 2024 ACADEMIC YEAR

The Department of Science and Innovation (DSI) and National Research Foundation (NRF) in partnership with the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) are pleased to announce the provisional NRF-DAAD master's and doctoral awards for funding in 2024. The awards have been made according to the strategic objectives of the NRF-DAAD master's and doctoral funding instruments, the DSI-NRF Postgraduate Funding Policy and the available budget. Candidates are either awarded at Full Cost of Study (FCS) or Partial Cost of Study (PCS). Successful applications for NRF-DAAD master's and doctoral scholarships are listed in the **Tables 1** and **2** respectively.

- Awards not taken up four (4) months after the awarding will be automatically cancelled, unless otherwise approved by the NRF.
- If your name does not appear in the Tables below or any other published list of successful applicants, it means you have not been awarded a scholarship for 2024.
- Feedback to unsuccessful candidates will be provided between January and March 2024.
- The NRF provides feedback to unsuccessful candidates via the NRF Connect against your application.
